Meals

In the spirit of our network’s mission of nurturing socially and emotionally resilient students, we have joined forces with other school districts in providing a community feeding location for young people in New Orleans. Beginning Wednesday, March 19th, we will offer “Grab and Go” breakfast and lunch distribution weekdays between the hours of 9:30 am and 12:00 pm at our Sarah T. Reed High School location. This free service is open to all children ages 18 and under, or enrolled in a New Orleans Public School. Students are encouraged to stop by Sarah T. Reed High School located at 5316 Michoud Blvd. We will continue to release new and updated details through robocalls, the network’s website, and social media outlets.

Remote Learning Resources

To ensure student growth and development, Einstein has created a learning framework that will support learning that can be done at home during the weeks that students remain at home. Additionally, we are working to provide **optional** educational resources for students during this time through our network website, einsteincharter.org. Please note that this is not required and will not take the place of the learning that happens in the classroom with a teacher on a daily basis. We will have more information on these enrichment items posted as soon as possible on our network website and district social media outlets.

Spring Break

We are awaiting further guidance from the New Orleans Public School System on the potential impacts to our school calendar. Once additional information becomes available, we will pass that on to you in regards to the status of the previously scheduled Easter/Spring Break holiday.

I am an Einstein employee. Do I still report to work?

All employees are on call and should follow the direction of their direct supervisor.

No. This is a free service.

Who can receive meals and does my child have to be with me?

It is open to all children ages 18 and under or those who are enrolled in a New Orleans Public School. Your child does not have to be with you.

Can I volunteer to help with meal distribution?

No volunteers are needed at this time. We appreciate the support, but it's best to limit the people involved in the process. We will reach out if we need help in the future.

How will the students make up the weeks of missed school?

The Louisiana Department of Education has advised that the required instructional time has been suspended and will not have to be made up. Once additional information becomes available, we will provide updates through the network website and social media outlets.
